Sailing from the East Pier at 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. (boarding time 8:30 a.m.), and again at 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. (boarding time 12:30 p.m.), children aged eight to 12 are invited to become a pirate for the day. Hunting for hidden treasure or singing a sea shanty, participants will experience the life of a buccaneer. The cruise goes on rain or shine, and the destination is at the discretion of Captain Eric.

The \$45 fee includes a *Shiver Me Timbers* lunch on the quarterdeck, a scavenger hunt, pirate games, face painting, and the chance to see and hear the ship’s canon in action, as you defend the three-masted schooner from phantom pirate ships sailing near Davey Jones’s Locker.
